

Cantrail seal


- Check that cantrail seal butts up to 'A' post seal correctly, the cantrail seal must not be distorted when the hood is closed.
- To adjust cantrail seal release hood and carefully slide seal either backwards or forwards in its channel.
- Ensure seals are located correctly in their channels.

'A' post seal



- Check that 'A' post seal is positioned square at the corner of the 'A' post and header.
- To adjust 'A' post seal remove 2 Torx screws securing header striker and remove striker.
- 3. Manoeuvre 'A' post seal to its correct position.
- Close hood and secure with opposite side hood catch, apply downward pressure on hood and check that 'A' post seal is aligning correctly.
- Release hood and fit header striker and secure with Torx screws, tighten to 6 Nm.

Cheater



76M2335

- Check position of cheater, the cheater must be parallel with 'A' post when viewed from the side and front of vehicle.
- If cheater is protruding out at the top when viewed from the front it will hold the door glass away from the seal.
- To access cheater adjusters remove door speaker See ELECTRICAL, Repairs.
